




Que.-Are you satisfied with the duration given for skill-based courses and projects?





 in the library.


Suggestions from Students on curriculum:

- More ways to integrate industry standards (work related) in the curriculum would really
 prepare students to face the challenges of the design world.
- More focus on skill base learning like sketching, Photoshop, and industry collaboration projects, weekly masterclass from industry.
- The program requires moderate expert level programming which is barely taught to the level required. To suggest, it would be optimal if the course focuses more on design thinking, UX research and problem solving and more thorough programming.
- Attending Design competitions or Exhibitions are comparatively low. Case studies and Industry visits should be made regularly and frequently to understand the current trends in material and how progressive the market.



Total number of feedbacks obtained on Curriculum from Faculty- 72




Que.-Are you satisfied with the duration given for skill-based courses and projects?





- According to 80% Faculty their suggestions taken into consideration to revise the curriculum.


Suggestions from Faculty on curriculum:

- Increase in industry visits and high-level design practitioner from industries should be invited more frequently to talk about latest design trends and industry requirements with students.



Suggestions from Employer on curriculum:






- It was great experience learning in MIT. I grew not only in terms of intellectuality but as

- Students must be made to understand what the reality of working as a transportation
 designer everyday are, instead of being sold the idea of it as a dream. The college offers
 a wide range of cross functional learning within departments and even the transportation
 design course curriculum does a good job in providing exposure to various domains of
 design for student to explore.
- My personal learning experience is I gain more practical knowledge rather than only theory. The work culture and environment are too good. There are no boundaries for the to explore the new things.

Suggestions from Alumni on curriculum:

- To incorporate new technologies like AR/VR, focus on skill development considering the global competition and presentation skills.
- To incorporate more opportunities for Fashion Communication students. To have more fashion centric projects as opposed to graphic design.
- Student should get good career concealing before they choose type of industry, they want to go in.
- Focus on more industry exposure to the students by bringing in design studios / companies.
